Who is this Infosheet for?

This Infosheet is designed to provide referral and contact information for Community Legal Centres (CLCs) operating in Victoria, specifically those assisting with **criminal law matters** (crimes, offences, infringements). CLCs are independent organisations providing free or low-cost legal assistance to members of the community, including legal advice and casework services as well as education and advocacy. If you are unable to afford private legal representation or assistance, CLCs may be able to help you with your legal matter.

If you need urgent legal assistance or advice, call Victoria Legal Aid (VLA) at 1300 792 387, Monday – Friday, 8am – 5pm. If you or another person are at immediate risk of harm, call 000.

If you are unsure which CLC may be able to help you, you can call the **Federation of Community Legal Centres (FCLC)** at **(03) 9652 1500** for assistance in finding the right CLC for you.

Please see below for a list of some CLCs in Victoria that are **able to assist with a criminal law matter**.¹ This not a comprehensive list. The ASRC does not make any endorsements or assurances as to the quality of any legal assistance received from any of the CLCs listed below.

Please note that a number of CLCs may have closed their offices or are not currently operating or operating with a reduced capacity due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. You should not attempt to visit a CLC's office without checking to see if they are currently open and should not do so if it would be a breach of current COVID-19 isolation or lockdown laws. Check the relevant CLC's website for more information and call or email before attending an office.
