Other free health services

According to a Victorian Government directive, all people seeking asylum in Victoria are entitled to free public health services, whether or not you have Medicare.

The public health services include:

- Public hospitals
- Ambulance services in emergency situations
- Community health services
- Mental health support
- Dental services
- Catch-up immunisations

If you require any pathology or imaging tests please come and see us.

You may need our help to get the free health care you are entitled to. If you have been refused health care in a hospital or other health service, or if you have been billed, please come and see us.

What we offer in our health clinic



Dentistry

Assistance with dental referrals to the Royal Dental Hospital or Community Health Services as required.



Health Education

Regular programs providing skills and knowledge for preventing health issues.



Medical Appointments

There is a doctor available most days at ASRC Health. if you do not have Medicare, you can access ASRC Health's doctor, with bookings required. If you have Medicare, you can get our support to access a community doctor.



Help with Medication Costs

To join the pharmacy program, you'll need a financial assessment, including 3 months of bank statements now and again in 6 months.



Vaccinations

Immunisation Nurses provide catch up vaccinations. Annual flu clinic available.*
*Bookings required. Contact us for more details.



Hearing Checks

Assistance with referrals to appropriate hearing services.



Mental health & Psychiatry

You can see a psychiatrist even if you do not have Medicare. Our doctor can write a referral letter for you.



Nursing Care

Nurses are available daily. We can book appointments with ASRC doctors or refer you to other health and community services.



Eye Care

We run a monthly eye clinic and can refer you to the Royal College of Optometry. We also cover up to \$50 for glasses, lenses, and frames.

Screening, information & services regarding women's health, including reproductive health.
