

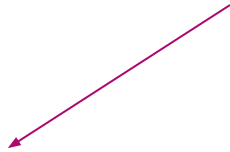

How to Enrol

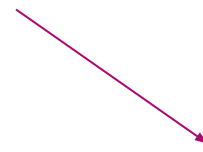
How to Enrol

When you have chosen your course, and you are ready to enrol you can:



Enrol yourself at the
Training Organisation

OR



Book an appointment
with the ASRC
Education Team

Self Enrolment

When you decide the course you would like to study, you can enrol directly with the TAFE or Training Organisation.

Before You Self Enrol:

- Check that the course has Skills First Funding (some Certificate courses have concession rates).
- Keep in touch with the ASRC Education and let them know what course you are enrolling in.
- Make an appointment with an ASRC Education Advisor if needed.
- Attend any Open Days at the TAFE or training organisation to explore and ask questions.

Self Enrolment (Documents)

When You Self Enrol:

Have the following documents ready:

- Visa document
- Passport or Immicard
- Acknowledgement of application of a Protection Visa to show that you have applied for a Protection type visa

The training organisation will:

- Complete a VEVO check
- Require you to complete a Language, Literacy & Numeracy (LLN) test
- Some courses may also require IELTS
